The club is the host the Int Moth Worlds in 2014.



Location


Hayling Island is located on the south coast of England near Portsmouth.

- 20 minutes from Portsmouth Ferry
- 30 minutes from Southampton Airport
- 1.5 hour from Gatwick
- 3 hours from Dover Ferries.
- 3 hours from Folkstone Eurotunnel.



SAILING AREA

- ❑ Racing to be held in open sea (English Channel).
- ❑ Ability to run courses in any direction.
- ❑ Small tidal effect (less 1.5 knots)
- ❑ Average 30 minutes or less sail to race area from club.
- ❑ Sailing area is free from commercial shipping.




Weather Data for HISC

Hayling Island Sailing Club is a National Centre of Excellence.

Rescue & Safety

HISC is an open sea venue and takes the safety of competitors taking part in Championships very seriously.

HISC has possibly one of the largest safety boat resources of any sailing club in the World and will be providing the highest competitor to safety boat ratio as required by the World Council.

During the Championship, HISC will employ a Safety Officer who will work with the PRO to look after the safety of competitors taking part in the Worlds. When necessary, safety briefings will be given so that competitors have all the information they require about conditions on the race course.
