## Introduction: Why Brest?



In terms of its lake covers an area of 184 Km2, and navigable area of 100 km2. The marina of Moulin Blanc where organizations sailing competitions site has an area of parking for boats of 12000 m2 with parking for storage of 3600 m2, with its municipal water watersports center resources available are very many.

In a city heavily influenced by the past history appears every corner. Thus, a simple walk downtown just to get into the history of Brest. Start by investing the Castle, the oldest building in the city. Old seventeen centuries, it houses the National Maritime Museum which exhibits all the military history of the city. After crossing the bridge Recouvrance, inaugurated in 1954, a stop at the Museum Tour Tanguy is an opportunity to historical immersion through models and dioramas. Close you will discover the Arsenal, one of the symbols of the city, created by Richelieu in 1631. As for the prison, work Choquet Lindu and strongly associated with the history of Brest, it was demolished shortly after the end of World War II. World War II, precisely, played a major role in the history of Brest, released in 1944 after months of bombing destructive.

### Moulin Blanc marina

Moulin Blanc marina is located at the bottom of the harbor of Brest. It includes all the conveniences necessary for sailing and the USAM sailing club.

With its 12,000 m<sup>2</sup> parking in front of the house clubs, wedges 2 launch, it can accommodate events of spans in good conditions.

The marina is easily accessible from the airport or train station




### Transport & accomodation
