In 2023 the Lübecker Yacht-Club will celebrate its 125th anniversary. To give this anniversary a special glamour, we are planning a broad and extremely attractive program for the 133rd Travemünde Week 2023, because the Travemünde Week was the reason why the Lübecker Yacht-Club was founded in the summer of the year 1898.

The F18 class has had a prominent place in the LYC for a long time, as the German Class Association was once founded on our club site and the F18 fleet based here is an important part of the sportive sailing in the LYC. We would be very happy if our application, which you will find on the next pages, would meet your interest.





Information about the History, Lübecker Yacht-Club and its partner sailing clubs

The Travemünder Woche was founded in 1889 when the Hamburg merchants Hermann Wentzel and Hermann Dröge competed against each other off Travemünde.

It was not until nine years later - in 1898 - that the Lübeck Yacht Club was founded following an appeal by Kaiser Wilhelm II to have an institution to professionally organize the Travemünde Week. Since then the Lübeck Yacht Club has been the main organizer of the sailing week. Co-organizers are the Hanseatic City of Lübeck, the Norddeutsche Regatta Verein (NRV) from Hamburg and the Zürcher Yacht-Club from Switzerland. Together with its partners, 350 volunteers are involved in the sport of sailing every year.

For decades the Travemünde Week has been the attraction for well over a thousand active sailors and several hundred thousand enthusiastic spectators and visitors every year, who enjoy both the major sporting event and the fine festival on land. Nowhere else in the world is the sailing sport so closely linked with a varied land program as in Travemünde. Family atmosphere, top-class sport, summer, beach feeling and shows are the highlights that distinguish the Travemünde week year after year.

In the recent past, the Travemünde Week has gained an outstanding reputation as a championship venue. Year after year the most different classes come to the mouth of the river Trave to fight their German, European or global title fights here. The Travemünder Woche is not only for the class associations, but also for the sailors the best opportunity to present themselves







Experience with Championships





- In the long history of the Travemünder Woche we have successfully organized many World, European and German championships in many different boat classes. In the last years these included:
- In 2012 we organized the 29er World Championship with more than 215 teams. In 2014 the 420er World Championships and the Yngling Worlds took place in Travemuende.
- In 2013 we hosted the Hobie Tiger, Wild Cat, Dragoon and Hobie 14 Worlds
- For 2015 we hosted the J22 Worlds and RS Feva Worlds.
- In 2016 we hosted the Worlds und Europeans of the RS Classes.
- In 2019 we hosted the German Championship in ORC Offshore Sailing.
- For the seventh time in a row we will host the German Sailing League.





Staff of Travemuende Week

Wind & Weather


- Average Temperature: Air: 21° Celsius, Water: 18 ° Celsius

- Average wind speed: 13 kn








SAILING ARENA TRAVE: Theatre racing for class presentation

Races of about 10 to 15 minutes – always short, sharp and punchy!

Easy to understand for spectators and with a great achievement to bring spectaculous sailing manouvers in all kinds of media – broadcasted by commentators and PA-system.





During the annual Travemuende Sailing Week the LYC-Team will present racing periods of 45 to 60 minutes on the river Trave in a special format starting at about 17,00 hours daily after official racing in Luebeck Bay during the day.





- Visit the beautiful old town of Lübeck with its numerous historical buildings such as the Holstentor, the Marienkirche or the Lübeck town hall.
- In the Hansemuseum you can learn everything about the Hanseatic League or enjoy the world-famous nut cake in the Cafe Niederegger.
