The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1st March 2005.

Rule B.1.4

Amendment: All underwater appendages must be symmetrical.

Rule B.1.4.2

Amendment: Change the maximum weight of daggerboards or centreboards from "7.0 kg" to "5.5 kg".

Rule E.2

Amendment: Add to the current rule "A paddle must meet the following minimum measurement requirements:

Blade – 14 cm wide (at the maximum width) and 25 cm long

Pole – 1 meter long and 20mm diameter".

B. Measurement Rules

Amendment: Add to current rule; "Regarding the legality of carbon snuffer arrangements, a carbon ring is used on the snuffer. The spinnaker pole is aluminium. Existing snuffers would be accepted under a grandfathering arrangement until 1 January 2007. Carbon is not permitted in the construction of new snuffers".
